6.	Two copies of the spouse's/parents/child's Belgian identity card or his/her residence permit in Belgium. This document can be obtained from the relevant municipality.

8.	Your plane ticket reservation with all flights confirmed + 1 copy					
9.	In case the Belgian spouse resided in China: copy of his/her Belgian passport with visas
